

Stuart has experienced homelessness, addiction and prison. Now he has his own flat, is free from drugs and is making a difference to others.

Stuart has started a paid internship at Glasgow City Mission, with Simon, Assistant Project Manager, supporting him. Stuart says, "I left rehab just over eight months ago. I was homeless and had no prospects. Glasgow City Mission took a chance on me and let me volunteer."

Stuart helps at the Drop-ins, spending time with the guests that come in. He says, "I love it – someone gave me that chance and I can give that to them and a bit of hope.

"Simon is my boss for the internship – with that I will get 21 hours paid work and my SVQ level 3. I've got a job at the Glasgow Winter Night Shelter. I've got my own tenancy for the first time in 42 years. Everything is going well. Two boys came back this week – one who is now five months clean and one who has been clean for nine days. I had spoken to them and told them about their options."

Simon says, "Stuart has been trusted with responsibility which has literally lifted his head high and made him smile. He is amazing at getting alongside guests. People who know him from his time on the streets can see a changed life in front of them."
