Pray that the paperwork would go through quickly and they would be able to access this life-saving support.
- Thank you for praying for a guest who was concerned about getting the grades required to progress to the next level of her studies. Give thanks she has been accepted for an art and design course. Pray for all our guests who will start new courses this term - that they would find appropriate support to alleviate any digital exclusion.
- We are gradually increasing our face to face work with guests. Please pray we would make connections with those who really need support and community. A lot of our activities will take place outdoors so please pray for sunshine!
- Our Street Outreach team are meeting lots of new people who are sleeping rough or begging. Give thanks they trust us and pray for wisdom in building relationships.
- One of our guests desperately needs a new home but this is proving frustratingly difficult. Please pray for breakthrough. Pray too for a guest who is recovering from surgery and another awaiting a procedure for a serious health condition – please pray for their physical health and for God's peace.
